



# The Czech Kin-Ball Federation is inviting you to the WORLD KIN-BALL<sup>®</sup> sport Club Championship.

#### **Tournament's Invitation**

The Czech Kin-Ball Federation invites players to register to the second World Club Championship of KIN-BALL® sport in Czechia (Czech Republic).

**Location of the tournament:** The town of Pardubice

**Dates and duration:** Thursday 22<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> of September 2016

Games will be played over 4 days

Category: Senior Mixed Gender Teams

Two tournaments / Two categories, both of them mixed gender:

**Amateur category**: Made for players who want to compete at an intermediate

level, being a more participative category with more flexible

rules.

**Pro category**: Made for players who want to compete at a higher level.

Recommended for national tram pretenders or experienced

players.

**Teams Composition:** Teams must be constituted of a maximum 10 players. During

the games, only 8 players are allowed there must always be 2 women and 2 men in a team on the court at all-time. All the participants have to be 18 years old or older on September

. 22<sup>th</sup> 2016.

Participation Rules: Contrary to KIN-BALL® sport World Cup, teams do NOT have

to belong to a country member of the International KIN-BALL®

sport Federation to participate in Club Championship.

If there is a federation in a country participants must be affiliated with a club which is affiliated with its national

federation.

A player can only register as a player in one team no matter

which event it takes part in.









Playing Rules: Official IKBF rules plus following specifications

Men and women have to alternate on a serve in one team.

See specific rule document for the details.

#### **Amateur category**

Close defense is not allowed See specific rule document for the details.

It could be possible that some rule testing will be done during the tournament See specific rule document for the details.

The game formula that will be used is still to be determined depending on the amount of teams that will register in this category.

Therefore 6 guaranteed preliminary games will be played.

Semi-finals and finals will be played using best 3 out of 7 periods as described in the official rulebook.

#### **Pro category**

Each game is played using best 3 out of 7 periods as described in the official rulebook with 13 points periods.

Each team will play 3 preliminary games plus semi-finals and finals.









#### Referees: Administrated by the IKBF

The amount of chosen referees will depend on the amount of teams. The IKBF will publish an application document during the month of March.

#### Registration fees:

250 Euros per team

#### Schedule:

Your arrival is scheduled on the day preceding the tournament, Wednesday September 21<sup>st</sup>. Your departure is scheduled on the day after the tournament, Monday September 26<sup>th</sup>. Beginning of the competition is scheduled on Thursday late afternoon, with the opening ceremony at about 14:00. If you plan to arrive on Thursday, please keep in mind to be ready in time for the Opening Ceremony.

#### **LODGING AND MEALS**

Standard – 290 Euros / 1 person
The cost includes meals and accommodation in the Trim hotel

Upper Standard – 350 Euros / 1 person
The cost includes meals and accommodation in the Euro hotel

If reservation is made and 50% paid by February 29<sup>th</sup>, there will be a rebate of 100 Euros per person for the Standard room and 60 Euros per person for the Upper Standard room.

#### REFRESHMENTS

Bottled water will be available free of charge in the hall during the tournament, there also is a canteen, where you can buy some kind of fast food and other refreshments.

#### **TRANSPORT**

#### **Traveling by plane:**

You will fly to Prague, our capital and then travel by train to Pardubice, which is situated 100 km east of Prague. The cost of transport is approximately 12 Euros per person, return ticket.

#### Traveling by train, bus or car:

If your team goes by train or by bus we expect your destination to be Pardubice.

This cost includes free public transport in town area during the time of the competition.










#### Pardubice is situated East of Prague




Sports hall – Dasicka / you can get there in 10 minutes from a hotel by the free public transportation

#### SUMMARY OF THE COST OF THE EVENT

**Registration fee:** 250 Euros per team

#### Lodging and food:

Standard: 290 Euros per person (five nights from September 22<sup>th</sup> till September 25<sup>th</sup>)

or

Upper Standard: 350 Euros per person (five nights from September 22<sup>th</sup> till September 25<sup>th</sup>)

This cost includes free public transport in town area during the time of the competition.

Transport from Prague's Airport to Pardubice and back:

12 Euros per person return ticket

## **NOTICE**

By the half of the February 2016 we need you to pay 50% of the price for meal and accommodation (half of 290 Euros or 350 Euros see above) in order to keep these prices. If you register and pay 50% by Monday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2016 you will get rebate of 100 Euros per person for Standard and 60 Euros per person for Upper Standard.
